COMMERCIAL PROPANE MOWER INCENTIVE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

The Propane Council of Texas is accepting applications for incentives on the purchase of new, dedicated, commercial, propane mowers and conversions of existing mowers.

Q. How do I participate in the Propane Council of Texas incentive program and convert commercial mower equipment to propane?

A. As a purchaser of commercial mowing equipment, you or the participating mower dealer must complete an incentive form for each mower purchased/converted. Conversions can only be performed on mowers with 200 hours or less.

Q. To be eligible, am I required to operate the equipment in a certain area?

A. Yes. Mowers for which you receive an incentive award must be operated in the state of Texas.

Q. What is an eligible unit?

A. New, factory direct Original Equipment from the Manufacturer (OEM) mowers and converted mowers that will displace at least 200 gallons of gasoline per unit per year are eligible for an incentive. Conversions must have less than 200 hours.

Q. How many incentives may I request?

A. There is a limit of 5 incentive awards per applicant.

Q. How long do I have to submit my incentive application?

A. You have 60 days from the time of a conversion and/or factory direct purchase to submit your application.

Q. After I submit my incentive application, how long will it take to receive a check?

A. If you have submitted a correctly completed application, it will generally take 6-8 weeks to receive your check.

Q. If I converted equipment before this program began, am I still eligible?

A. No. Only OEM factory direct purchases and conversion made after June 28, 2010 are eligible for an incentive.

Q. Since this program is designed to reduce gasoline consumption, are there any requirements?

A. Yes. You are required to displace a minimum of 200 gallons of gasoline each year the mower is in use. As part of the incentive you are required to submit a PRE and POST SEASON ProCOT SURVEY which you receive with your application.

Q. Who converts the equipment?

A. All eligible propane mowers/engines must be Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and/or California Air Resource Board (CARB) certified. Conversions can only be performed by certified LPG technicians at participating Service Dealers.

Q. How long will this program exist?

A. This program is subject to available funds with incentive applications accepted on a first-come first-serve basis until funds are expended.
